

field tested the methamphetamine which had a presumptive positive for the presence of methamphetamine.

Surveillance units followed Manuel SANCHEZ to the area of Granger where surveillance was subsequently terminated.

Detectives learned that the registered owner of the Dodge Caravan, Manuel SANCHEZ, was the same person aforementioned as Manuel LNU. Detectives also learned that Manuel SANCHEZ resided at 104 East Maple Way, Sunnyside, Washington.

On July 9, 2012, the CS was directed by Detective Sanchez in negotiating the purchase of another ½ ounce of methamphetamine for \$620.00 U.S. currency from Manuel SANCHEZ. During the same time, a Washington State Department of Licensing Driver's License photograph of Manuel SANCHEZ was shown to the CS who positively identified that person of being Manuel LNU.

Surveillance was then established in the area of the Home Depot parking lot located at 2115 South 1st Street, Yakima, Washington.

At approximately 5:04 p.m., Manuel SANCHEZ arrived driving the white Dodge Caravan (WA Plate AHX1434) and parked a short distance from the CS. SANCHEZ then exited his vehicle and ran over the CS's vehicle and made contact with the CS through the driver's window.
