, being first duly sworn on oath, deposes and says: That affiant is a DETECTIVE commissioned and employed by the Franklin County Sheriff's Office. That he believes that probable cause exists for the arrest and detention of the above-named defendant in that records made and kept in the regular course of business and as business records thereof reflect as follows:

On July 22, 2012, at 0219 hours Deputy George Rapp and member of the Franklin County Sheriff's Office responded to 7441 Glade Road. Dispatch stated there was a burglary at the residence. Dispatch also stated that the suspect in that burglary also attempted to rape an 11 year old girl L.S.R. (D.O.B.: 03/20/2001). Deputy Rapp observed a white bald male, wearing light colored shorts and a black tank top walking south on Glade, just south of Selph Landing. The male was identified as Kable Gunter (04/24/1974).

Further investigation revealed that Gunter, along with Terry M. Hoefler and Tahti T. Dilkey had been traveling North on Glade in Hoefler's truck. The truck broke down in front of the victim's residence. Both males went into the residence and stole several items while Dilkey waited outside in the truck. L.S.R. stated that during that burglary, one of the two men picked her up and carried her out into the living room area, put his hand over her mouth, told her to be quiet, placed a bag in her mouth, bent her over the couch, and pulled her pants off. Eventually the bag fell out of her mouth and she was able to scream. The aunt of the victim then awoke and her boyfriend call 911.

The children in the home gave an description of Gunter to Dispatch and later identified him at a show up as being in the home. Several hours after the investigation law enforcement found Hoefler fleeing in a nearby field. After being detained they saw Hoefler wore one of L.S.R.'s skirts and was sexually aroused at the time of his arrest. Hoefler admitted to being involved in the burglary. The stolen items were found in the irrigation ditch near where Hoefler was arrested.

Dilkey confirmed that the two individuals had been gone from the truck for about two hours. She also said when Hoefler returned he wiped down the truck for prints and told her he had been spotted by a young girl.
